Craig Brown, a current Recreation Center of Sun City board member, is running for re-election and this is the time for the members to send a message: Give us back our Membership meetings!

Craig Brown has been a leader in closing legal committee meetings. He was responsible for changing the membership meeting quorum from 100 to 1,250, even though state statute forbids a board from raising membership meeting quorums. He was told his ideas were illegal and his response was to stop legal committee meetings. His response to the members circulating a petition drive was to shorten the time limit from six months to three and to not allow petition circulation on RCSC property.

This group of board members created “commissions” that closed the bids to the members. He was behind the trust debacle, where they tried to get people to double their assessments

by signing away their grandfathered per-person facilities agreement.

It’s time for a “brown out.”
